

Tutoring Policy

Tutoring is an activity that relates to the library's role as an educational support center. Because the library has limited space and no appropriate study rooms, use of library space for tutoring will be permitted only when coordinated with the Library Staff.

The following guidelines are to be observed:

Tutors shall call ahead to ensure there will be no conflict with other library programs or services.

The library reserves the right to refuse the use of library space for paid services.

Tutors may tutor one student only at a time.

Children under 18 years of age who are tutored in the library are the responsibility of the tutor while on library property until released to a parent/guardian or to authorized transportation.

The Library is not responsible for providing any special equipment for a tutor's use.

Tutors may not use the library to solicit business.

All other library policies will be observed while tutoring in the library.
